[Have teacher bag & souvenir poster handy]

We want to see you listening carefully, treating everyone respectfully, moving through the venue safely and silently and most importantly, and showing lots of love and 'Chookas' to the other schools here today.

At Wakakirri we make a 'W' with our hands and when we're in places that we can make noise, we say 'Chookas' because it means good luck and best wishes for an amazing performance.

So before I hand you over to [Marshal], let's try one together.

You can even use the Media Wall for filming, that's you will all get your professional portrait photos taken before the show tonight. So better get your best poses ready, too!

You three must stay in your fabulous costumes after you've performed and right until the very end of the presentation ceremony, don't forget!

I'll be keeping my eyes and ears wide open today on the lookout for the school that will win our Spirit of Wakakirri Award tonight... So that means being respectful, quiet-as-mice and following all instructions perfectly as well showing everyone else here lots of love and chookas!
